ABA Legal Opportunity Scholarship Fund

The ABA Legal Opportunity Scholarship Fund currently is expected to award \$5,000 of financial assistance annually per student. An award made to an entering freshman may be renewable for each year, resulting in financial assistance totaling \$15,000 during, his or her three years of law school. During the initial academic year of the fellowship, fellows typically participate in a recognized teacher credentialing program. In order to be eligible and applicant must be pursuing a teaching related career in public education and be a member of a defined ethnic minority group. National Institute of Health--Undergraduate Scholarship Program (UGSP)

\$20,000. The NIH program offers scholarship awards to students from disadvantaged backgrounds that are committed to **careers in biomedical research**. The scholarships pay for tuition and reasonable educational and living expenses up to \$20,000 per academic year. Recipients are obligated to serve as paid employees in NIH research laboratories after graduation. National Medical Fellowship

Amounts vary based on financial need. NPSC (National Physical Science Consortium) Graduate Fellowships in the Physical Sciences

NPSC offers a six year, fully-funded, doctoral fellowship program, the value of which can exceed \$200,000 depending on the cost of the university attended by the NPSC fellow. The Consortium comprises leading universities and private corporations and governmental research laboratories (who provide stipends and two summers of employment). National Science Foundation (NSF)

The National Science Foundation (NSF) is an independent federal agency created by Congress in 1950 "to promote the progress of science; to advance the national health, prosperity, and welfare; to secure the national defense..."
