



Applications for a Marshall Scholarship **require institutional endorsement**. The Undergraduate Research and Creative Activities (URCA) Office, North Hall 2105, (805) 893-2319, coordinates the institutional endorsement process for this scholarship. Endorsement is determined by a committee of faculty and professional staff members who evaluate your application using the same selection criteria followed by the Marshall Selections Committee. It is highly recommended that you consult with a professor in your area of interest throughout your application preparation. The Campus Learning Assistance Services (CLAS) staff will be available throughout the summer to help you with the preparation of your personal statement. You may **obtain scholarship information and access to the online application at www.marshallscholarship.org**.

September 6, 2007, is the **absolute deadline** for receipt of materials necessary for the review of UCSB applications for a Marshall Scholarship. The applications should be in final format, with close attention to grammar, spelling and content. Submit the following for campus endorsement:

1. One copy of the online application*
2. Unofficial transcripts from all of the colleges or universities you have attended. Remember, you should request your official transcripts early and have them sent to you directly. **DO NOT** open the transcripts. Instead, note your ID code and forward them to the appropriate regional center.

*All letters of recommendation must be submitted online by the **September 6** deadline in order for the application to be considered for campus endorsement. Please alert all letter writers of this deadline.

All of the above materials must be received **no later than 4 p.m. on September 6, 2007**.
